Facility: Hocking Hills State Park is located near the town of Logan, Ohio, southeast of Columbus. We will be camping either at the group campground. We will be camping in tents.

March weather can be unpredictable. Parents, please double-check the gear your son has packed against the checklist (to be provided).

Activity: The highlight activity of this campout is exploring the six scenic geologic areas of the State Park: Old Man's Cave, Cedar Falls, Ash Cave, Conkles Hollow, Rock House and Cantwell Cliffs. These areas are carved out of sandstone by the forces of erosion. The caves are large recess caves. There are narrow gorges, waterfalls, cliffs, potholes and a house of rock. These areas are awesome to see and a lot of fun to explore. Go to www.HockingHillsPark.com for more information.

The scenic areas are accessible by short trails. Our exploration will go on regardless of the weather, so plan accordingly by bringing warm layers, waterproof rain gear and hiking boots.
